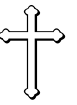

**Gospel Reflections - John 6:1-15** When large crowds gather, exciting and unexpected things can happen. That's the way it was when Jesus went up on a mountain shortly before the Passover feast. He had no idea that a crowd of five thousand would soon gather around him. They were determined to hear him speak and to see what great signs he might work. Unlike his disciples, Jesus was not concerned about how this huge crowd was to be fed on a few loaves and fishes. In familiar actions we recognize, Jesus took the bread, broke it, blessed it and gave it to his guests. When the crowd realized that everyone had been fed and there were still leftovers, they were astounded. They wanted to carry Jesus off on their shoulders and make him their king.

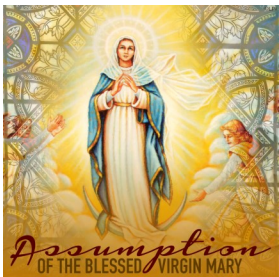

**Parish Auction:** I know that some have been wondering whether or not St Boniface will have the auction this year. In consultation with the Finance Council, it has been decided not to hold the Parish Auction for St Boniface this year. Some of the reasons for this decision are as follows:

- 1) Hope that those who support the auction both with donations and by purchasing items will allocate what they would give to support the auction toward Sunday/Holy Day giving and/or other avenues of donating such as commodities, stocks, and IRA, Estate, or Social Security transfers all of which can have tax benefits.
- 2) St Boniface currently has enough money in savings/CDs to cover minor operating deficits if they continue and are not reversed in the immediate years.
- 3) The introduction in early 2019 of a new parish mission with the opportunity to support it, and
- 4) The uncertain availability of an auctioneer.

The above four reasons are why it was decided for St Boniface not to have the parish auction this year. I hope that you will understand and I plan to give a report of the parish finances along with an explanation of different ways one can support the parish in September/October 2018.
